1. What is sin?

"All unrighteousness is sin" 1 John 5:17

"Whoever commits sin also commits lawlessness, and sin is lawlessness" 1 John 3:4

"I would not have known sin except through the law" Romans 7:7

2. What problem do all humans face?

"All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" Romans 3:23

"The wages of sin is death" Romans 6:23

"If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves" I John 1:8

3. Does sin impact our relationship with God?

"But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden His face from you, So that He will not hear" Isaiah 59:2

"Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."" John 3:3

4. Can we save ourselves from sin?

"I know that in me...nothing good dwells; for to will is present with me, but how to perform what is good I do not find" Romans 7:18

"O wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death?" Romans 7:24, 25

5. Who can save us?

"But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved)" Ephesians 2:4, 5

"But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ" 1 Corinthians 15:57

"God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life" John 3:16

"Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law" Galatians 3:13

6. What must I do to be saved?

"Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved" Acts 16:31

"If you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved" Romans 10:9

"God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life. These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life, and that you may continue to believe in the name of the Son of God" 1 John 5:11-13

"There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit" Romans 8:1

7. How did Jesus save us?

"In due time Christ died for the ungodly. For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die. But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him" Romans 5:6-9

"Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures" 1 Corinthians 15:3

"We see Jesus...for the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone" Hebrews 2:9

8. What does Jesus' death mean for me?

"According to the law almost all things are purified with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no remission" Hebrews 9:22

"Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit" 1 Peter 3:18

"He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him" 2 Corinthians 5:21

9. Why would Jesus lay his life down for me?

"The Lord has appeared of old to me, saying: "Yes, I have loved you with an everlasting love; Therefore with lovingkindness I have drawn you." Jeremiah 31:3

"God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us" Romans 5:8

"Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends" John 15:13

10. Will God really forgive all my sins?

"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" 1 John 1:9

"Says the Lord...I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more. He will again have compassion on us, And will subdue our iniquities. You will cast all our sins Into the depths of the sea" Hebrews 8:9, 12

"Who is a God like You, Pardoning iniquity And passing over the transgression of the remnant of His heritage? He does not retain His anger forever, Because He delights in mercy." Micah 7:18, 19

11. Does Jesus want us to stay in our sin after we are saved?

"Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out" Acts 3:19

"Truly, these times of ignorance God overlooked, but now commands all men everywhere to repent" Acts 17:30

"When Jesus had raised Himself up and saw no one but the woman, He said to her, "Woman, where are those accusers of yours? Has no one condemned you?" She said, "No one, Lord." And Jesus said to her, "Neither do I condemn you; go and sin no more."" John 8:10, 11

"I tell you...unless you repent you will all likewise perish" Luke 13:3

12. How can we show love to Jesus for saving us?

""If you love Me, keep My commandments."" John 14:15
