

**1. Who does the Bible say Jesus is?**

"And suddenly a voice came from heaven, saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."" Matthew 3:17

"God...has in these last days spoken to us by His Son, whom He has appointed heir of all things...who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high...But to the Son He says: "Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; A scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your kingdom."" Hebrews 1:1-3, 8

**2. Who does Jesus say He is?**

"I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last" Revelation 22:13

"Jesus answered them, "My Father has been working until now, and I have been working." Therefore the Jews sought all the more to kill Him, because He not only broke the Sabbath, but also said that God was His Father, making Himself equal with God" John 5:17,18

"I and My Father are one." Then the Jews took up stones again to stone Him. Jesus answered them, "Many good works I have shown you from My Father. For which of those works do you stone Me?" The Jews answered Him, saying, "For a good work we do not stone You, but for blasphemy, and because You, being a Man, make Yourself God."" John 10:30-33

**3. How does Jesus relate to God the Father?**

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God...And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth" John 1:1,14

"...I and My Father are one."" John 10:30

"He is the image of the invisible God" Colossians 1:15

**4. Was Jesus born by normal circumstances?**

"Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel" Isaiah 7:14

"Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows: After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Spirit. So all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying: "Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which is translated, "God with us."" Matthew 1:18, 22, 23

#### **5. Did Jesus exist before He was born?**

"Out of you shall come forth to Me, The One to be Ruler in Israel, Whose goings forth are from of old, From everlasting" Micah 5:2

"Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM."" John 8:58

"And now, O Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was" John 17:5

"For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me" John 6:38

#### **6. What special event did Jesus have a part in**

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made" John 1:1-3

"For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him" Colossians 1:16

#### **7. Can Jesus relate to humans?**

"Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness"" Genesis 1:26

"Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil" Matthew 4:1

"For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin" Hebrews 4:15

**8. What problem do all humans face?**

"All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" Romans 3:23

"Your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden His face from you" Isaiah 59:2

"The wages of sin is death" Romans 6:23

**9. Can Jesus save us from sin?**

"God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us" Romans 5:8

"For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord" Romans 6:23

"Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ...who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him" 2 Corinthians 5:20, 21

**10. What happened to Jesus after His death?**

"Therefore My Father loves Me, because I lay down My life that I may take it again. No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This command I have received from My Father." John 10:17,18

"He said to them, "Do not be alarmed. You seek Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He is risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid Him" Mark 16:6

"We were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father" Romans 6:4

"If we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus" 1 Thessalonians 4:14

**11. Does Jesus really love me?**

"I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord" Romans 8:38-39

"Since you were precious in My sight, You have been honored, And I have loved you...Fear not, for I am with you" Isaiah 43:4, 5

"I love those who love me, And those who seek me diligently will find me" Proverbs 8:17

"The Lord your God in your midst, The Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing" Zephaniah 3:17

### **12. Will Jesus accept anyone no matter how bad we are?**

"The blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin...If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us" 1 John 1:7-9

"As many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God" John 1:12

"And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely" Revelation 22:17

### **13. Does Jesus have a plan for my life?**

"I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope." Jeremiah 29:11
